FORMAT

In all tournaments, students play in pairs. Games are limited to 25 minutes per team (50 minutes total) and a SCRABBLE® clock is used. Both teams keep track of the score and verify the score throughout the game. At the end of a game, students report who won and the scores. For consecutive rounds, players are matched against players with similar records. We follow the official rules outlined for School SCRABBLE® tournaments, which are available on our website at www.schoolscrabble.ca.
